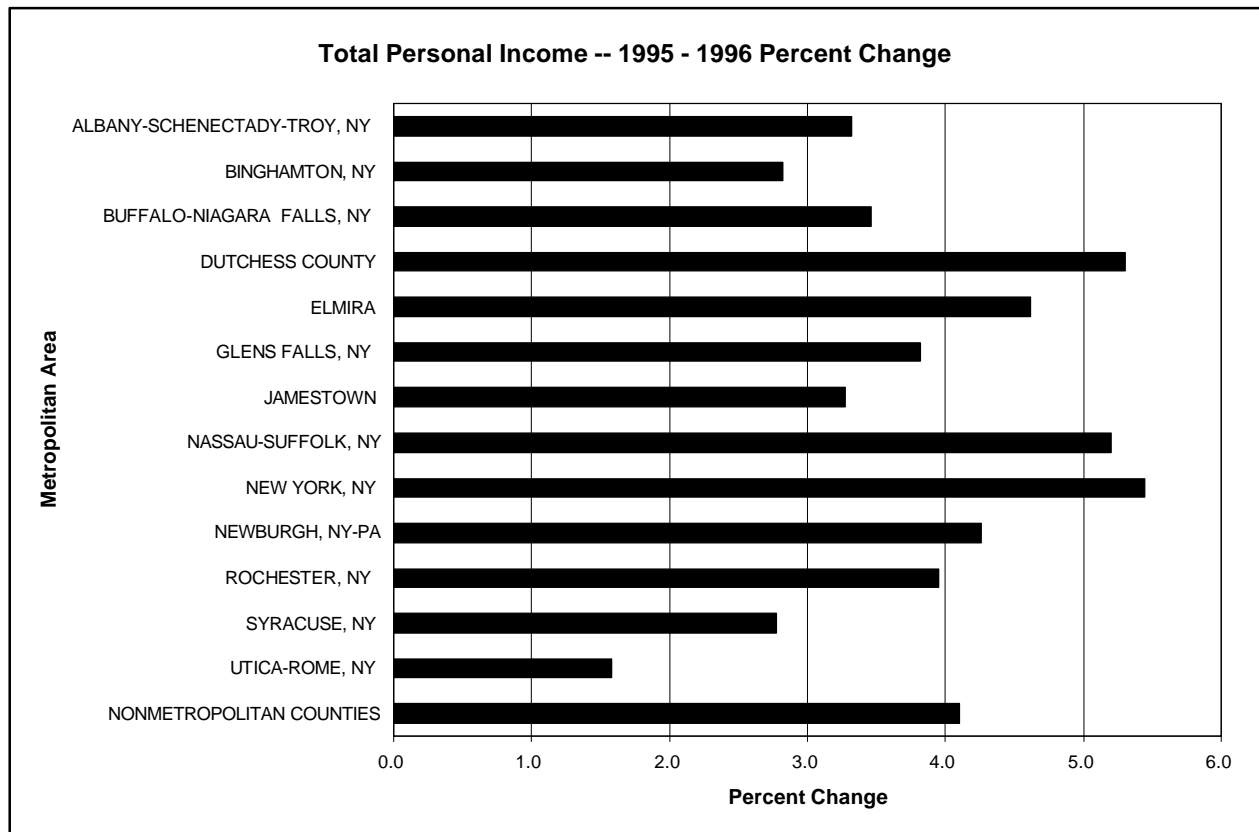
This publication presents 1996 New York State personal income estimates for areas (as defined on page 9) and counties, with revised estimates for 1995 and 1994. Personal income by major sources, including labor and proprietors' income by major industry group for each county and metropolitan area for 1969-1996 and additional copies of this report are available upon request from Empire State Development, Bureau of Economic and Demographic Information, One Commerce Plaza, Albany, New York 12245. Commerce. The data included in this report supersede income data previously issued that appears in the *New York State Department of Economic Development Research Bulletin No. 64, Personal Income in Areas and Counties of New York State, 1995.*

TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Personal income in New York State rose to a total of \$529.9 billion in 1996 – an increase of \$24.5 billion, or 4.9 percent compared with 1995. This was a smaller increase than the 5.6 percent rise registered by the nation as a whole. The State's total personal income was the second highest in the nation following only California. However, the rate of increase was lower than the national average with the State ranking 36th when compared with all 50 states and the District of Columbia, up from 37th during 1995.

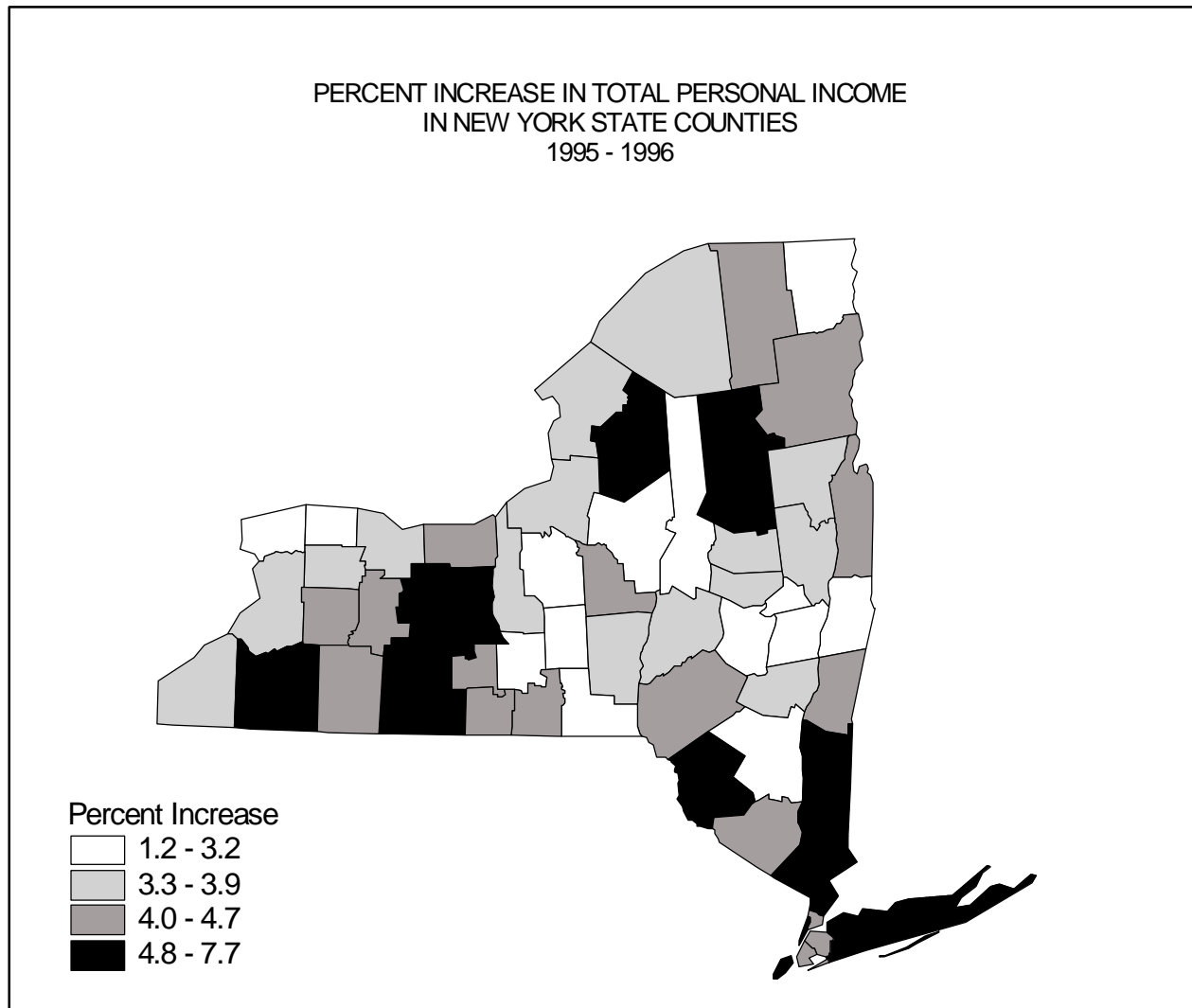
Total personal income in the combined metropolitan portion of the State was \$501.5 billion, up 4.9 percent from 1995. The nonmetropolitan portion of the State had a total personal income of \$28.4 billion in 1996, an increase of 4.1 percent from the previous year.

In the State's largest metropolitan area, the New York, NY PMSA (Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area), personal income totaled \$285.2 billion, an increase of 5.4 percent over 1995. New York City, the major portion of this area, increased 5.3 percent from 1995, reaching \$234.2 billion. The Nassau-Suffolk, NY PMSA registered a

total personal income of \$89.9 billion, 5.2 percent higher than the previous year.

Among the upstate metropolitan areas, gains in total personal income compared with 1995 ranged from 5.3 percent in the Dutchess County, NY MSA to 1.6 percent in the Utica-Rome, NY MSA.

New York's economic development regions all showed increases in total personal income. The Mid-Hudson region had the fastest growth in personal income (5.5 percent). The slowest growth occurred in the Mohawk Valley region (2.2 percent).



All of the State's counties registered increases in total personal income over 1995, ranging from 7.7 percent down to 1.2 percent.

Among the counties, Sullivan led all others in the rate of personal income growth in 1995 (7.7 percent), followed by New York (6.7 percent) and Lewis (6.5 percent). The smallest increases occurred in Oneida (1.2 percent), Clinton (1.7 percent) and Onondaga (2.3 percent) counties.

PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

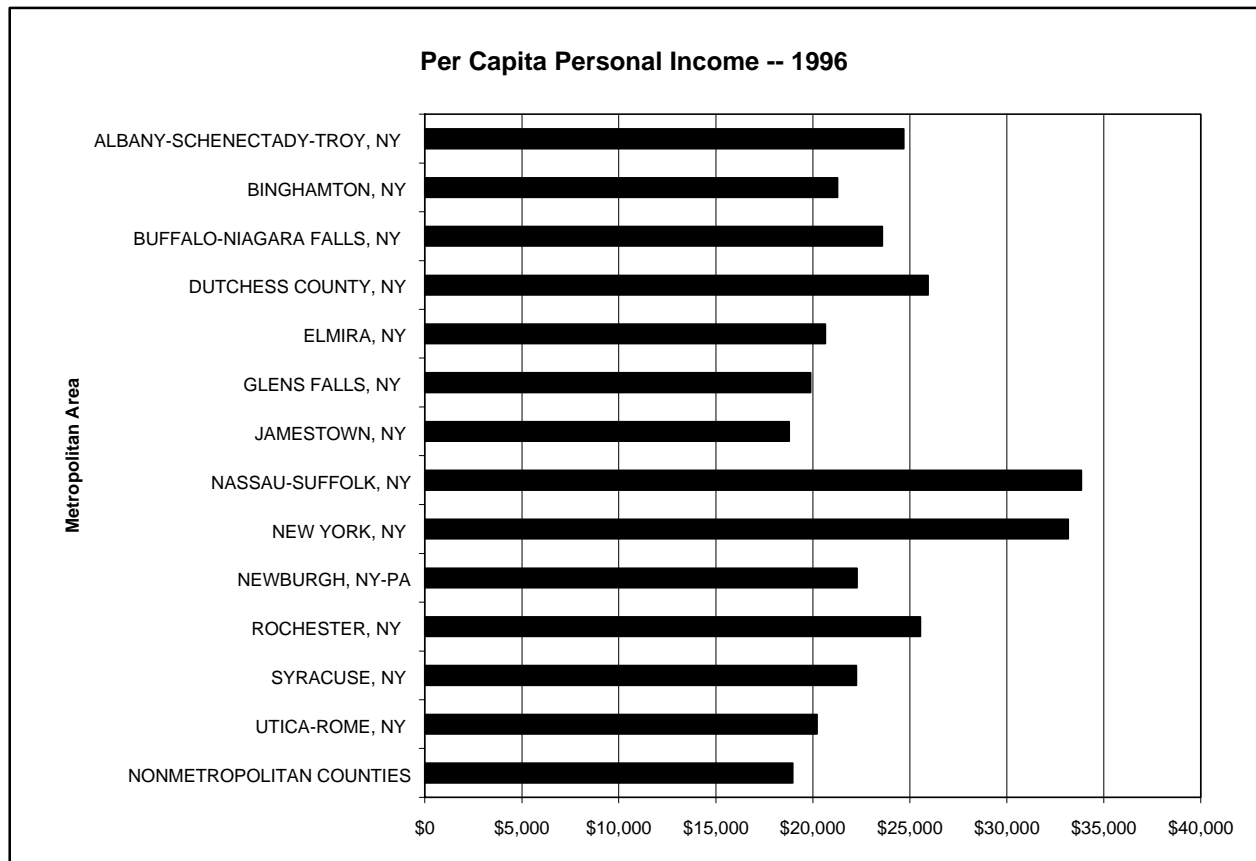
Statewide, per capita personal income was \$29,221 in 1996. The State's per capita personal income was nearly 20 percent greater than the national per capita personal income of \$24,436. Also, this per capita personal income was the fourth highest among the states in the nation following Connecticut (\$34,172), New Jersey (\$31,265) and

Massachusetts (\$29,808).

Between 1995 and 1996, the State's per capita personal income rose 4.9 percent compared with a national increase of 4.6 percent. This faster than the national average rate of increase ranked 18th in the nation, up from 23rd between 1994 and 1995.

Per capital personal income in the combined metropolitan portion of the State was \$30,143, up 5.0 percent since 1995. In the nonmetropolitan portion of the State, per capita personal income was \$18,968, up 4.2 percent from 1995.

The highest per capita personal incomes among the State's metropolitan areas were recorded in the Nassau-Suffolk, NY PMSA (\$33,837) and New York, NY PMSA (\$33,177). The metropolitan areas with the

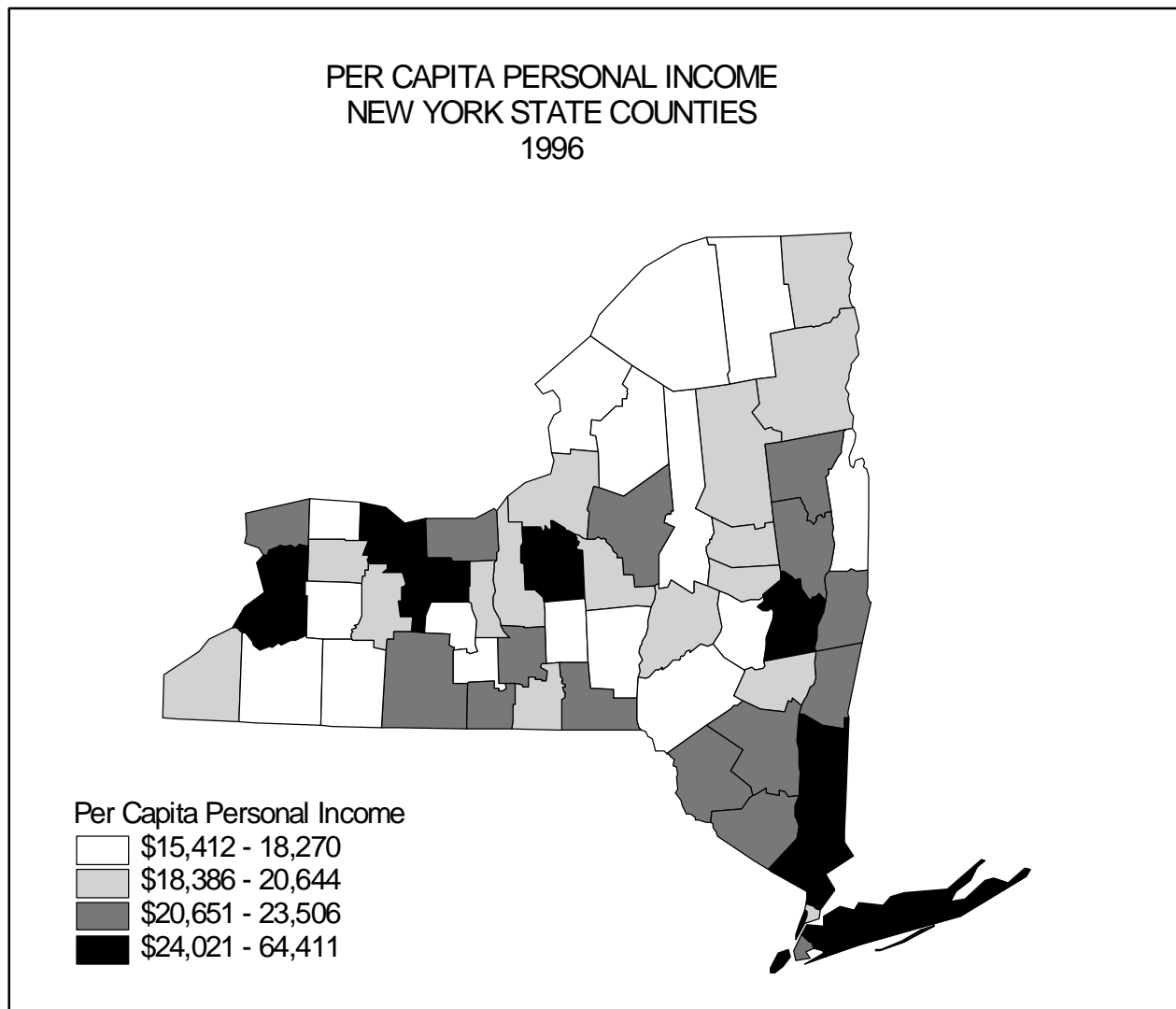


fastest growth in per capita personal incomes were the New York, NY PMSA (5.4 percent) and the Elmira, NY MSA (5.2 percent). The slowest growth in per capita personal income was in the Newburgh, NY-PA PMSA (3.2 percent) followed by the Syracuse, NY MSA (3.3 percent) and the Jamestown, NY MSA (3.4 percent).

The Long Island economic development region had the highest per capita personal income in the State at \$33,837. This was followed by the Mid-Hudson region (\$33,758). The North Country region had the lowest per capita personal income at \$17,110. The next lowest per capita personal income was in the Mohawk Valley region at \$19,912.

At 5.4 percent the New York City economic development region had the fastest growth in per capita personal income during 1996. The Mid-Hudson region was next at 5.1 percent. The slowest growth in per capita personal income occurred in the Central New York region (3.2 percent), followed by the Capital region and the Mohawk Valley (3.6 percent each).

The leader among all of the State's counties in per capita personal income in 1996 was New York County (\$64,411). Westchester County ranked second (\$43,921) followed by Nassau County (\$38,441). The lowest per capita personal incomes were registered in the predominantly rural counties



of Lewis (\$15,412), Franklin (\$15,967), St. Lawrence (\$15,994), and Allegany (\$15,997).

Per capital personal income grew in each of the State's counties with Sullivan County registering the fastest growth (7.5 percent), followed by Steuben County (6.6 percent) and New York County (6.1 percent). Chenango County showed the slowest growth at 2.4 percent. This was followed by Orleans, Tompkins, and Schoharie counties with 2.6 percent growth each.

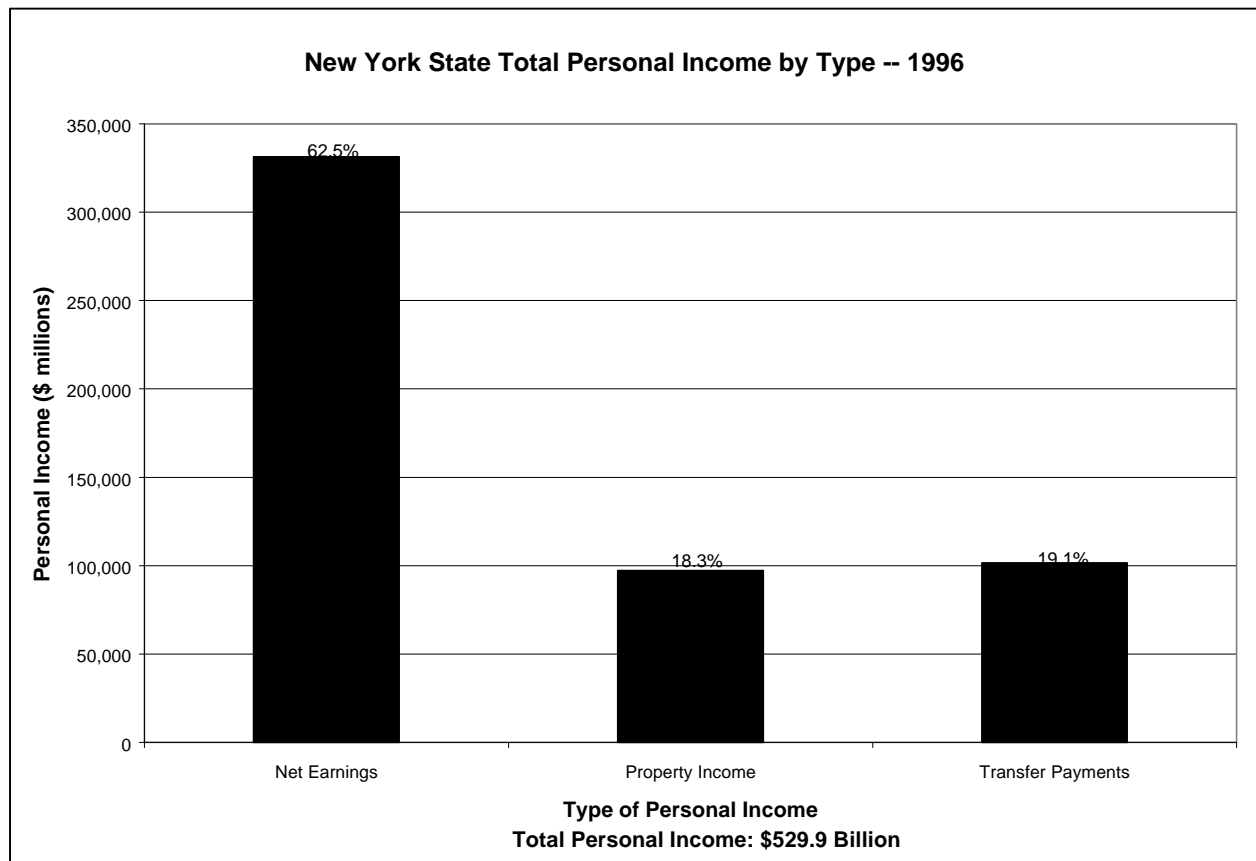
SOURCE OF PERSONAL INCOME

Statewide, net earnings increased 4.7 percent from 1995 to 1996. Among the counties, the fastest growth in this income component was in Sullivan County (9.1 percent), followed by Lewis (8.1 percent), and

New York (7.3 percent) counties. Only Oneida County (-0.7 percent) showed a reduction in this component.

Net earnings comprised 62.5 percent of the State's total personal income in 1996. The share of total personal income accounted for by this component was largest in Putnam (71.6 percent), Saratoga (69.2 percent) and Wayne (68.8 percent) counties. This component as a share of personal income was smallest in Hamilton (45.2 percent), Delaware (51.8 percent) and Bronx (53.7 percent) counties.

Property income in the State advanced 4.9 percent between 1995 and 1996. The growth in this component ranged from 6.1 percent in Tompkins County to 4.0 percent in Bronx County.



Statewide, property income accounted for 18.3 percent of total personal income in 1996. Hamilton County led all counties in the relative size of this component (29.6 percent), followed by Westchester County (25.2 percent), Nassau (24.5 percent) and Tompkins (22.7 percent) counties. As a share of personal income, this component was the smallest in Bronx (10.4 percent) and Oswego (11.1 percent) counties.

Transfer payments to New York State residents rose 5.4 percent during 1996. The counties with the greatest growth in this component were Rockland and Sullivan (6.6 percent each). The slowest growth in this component of personal income occurred in Herkimer (2.6 percent) and Oneida (3.2 percent) counties.

Transfer payments to residents of the State represented 19.2 percent of total income in 1996. Among the counties, this proportion was greatest in Bronx County (35.9 percent) followed by Kings (30.2 percent), Montgomery (27.1 percent) and Allegany (26.9 percent) counties. This component as a share of personal income was the smallest in

New York County (11.5 percent), followed by Putnam (11.7 percent), Westchester (12.3 percent) and Nassau (13.4 percent) counties.

WAGES AND SALARIES BY PLACE OF WORK

Wages and salaries received from New York State employers, \$302.1 billion in 1996, increased 5.8 percent compared with 1995. Over one-half of the State's total payroll came from employers in three counties, New York (\$126.0 billion), Nassau (\$20.2 billion) and Suffolk (\$17.4 billion). The counties contributing the least to the State's payroll were Hamilton (\$30.6 million), Schuyler (\$103.1 million) and Yates (\$118.2 million).

The largest payroll growth among counties was in Sullivan (12.2 percent), followed by New York (9.3 percent) and Steuben (7.7 percent) counties. Eight counties had declines in payroll. The largest decline was in Herkimer County (-4.7 percent), followed by Orleans County (-4.5 percent) and Livingston County (-1.3 percent).

DEFINITIONS

Personal Income: The income received by residents of an area from all sources before deductions for income and other personal taxes but after deductions for individuals' contributions to social security, government retirement and other social-insurance programs. It includes income received from business; federal, State and local governments; households; institutions; and foreign governments.

Per-Capita Income: Total personal income of residents divided by the estimated resident population, provided by the U.S. Bureau of the Census.

Per-capita income figures should be used with caution for a number of reasons. In some instances, an unusually high or low per-capita income figure for a county is because of temporary conditions, such as a major construction project (e.g., a dam or nuclear plant) or a catastrophe (e.g., a flood). Also, a county with a large institutional population (e.g., residents of a college or inmates of a correctional institution) may show an unusually low per-capita income.

Earnings: Wages and salaries (covering all employee earnings including tips, bonuses, commissions and payments in kind); supplementary earnings termed "other labor income," consisting mainly of employer contributions to private pension and welfare funds; and proprietors' income, consisting of the net business earnings of owners of unincorporated enterprises, including the independent professions and farms.

TYPES OF PERSONAL INCOME

Net Earnings: Earnings less personal contributions for social insurance.

Property Income: Rental income (and the imputed rent of owner-occupied houses), dividends, interest and royalties.

Transfer Payments: Receipts of persons from government and business for which no services are currently rendered, such as old-age, survivors, disability and health insurance benefits; railroad and public employees' pensions; food stamps; veterans benefits; supplemental security income; relief payments; and military pensions.

FACT SHEETS AVAILABLE FOR AREAS AND COUNTIES

The U.S. Department of Commerce has released BEA Regional FACT Sheets, or BEARFACTS, a one-page narrative that describes an area's personal income.

BEARFACTS contains four sections, each addressing one facet of personal income: per-capita personal income, total personal income, the components of total personal income and earnings by major industry. The per-capita and total personal income sections include current estimates, growth rates and comparisons of the area's income to other local areas and to the nation. The other sections list the area's most important sources of income by what percent of income they generate and how fast they are growing.

BEARFACTS is available on diskette for the State and its metropolitan areas and counties in two standard time frames. One presents changes over a 10-year period (1986-1996); the other, changes from the previous year (1995-1996).
