

**CONSUMER PRICE INDEX -ALL URBAN CONSUMERS
UNITED STATES & NEW YORK-NORTHERN N.J.-LONG ISLAND, NY-NJ-CT AREA**

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) is a measure of the average change in prices over time in a fixed market basket of goods and services. The CPI for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) covers approximately 80 percent of the total population. The CPI-U includes in addition to wage earners and clerical workers, groups such as professional, managerial, and technical workers, the self-employed, short-term workers, the unemployed, retirees, and others not in the labor force. The CPI is used as an indicator of inflation, a deflator of other economic series, and as an escalator for income payments.

METHODOLOGY

The CPI is based on prices of food, clothing, shelter, transportation, medical care and the other goods and services that people buy for day-to-day living. The Index measures price changes from a designated reference date -- 1982-1984=100.

REVISIONS:

Data is received monthly. No revisions are made, although the base year is subject to change over a period of time.
