



Productions participating in the New York State Film Production and Post-Production Tax Credit programs are eligible to receive a 30% - 40% tax credit on qualified wages and costs.

As New York State makes increased diversity of the production industry workforce a priority, all participating productions are required to create and implement diversity plans which including setting diversity goals, demonstrating that they have made good-faith efforts to meet these goals including promoting and encouraging the hiring of suppliers and subcontractors who represent the diversity of the State's population as a condition of receiving tax credits.

As part of the application process, productions are required to submit diversity data on the gender and race/ethnicity of the suppliers and subcontractors they hire. Empire State Development has created this tracking sheet as a tool that production companies may use in order to collect diversity impact data on suppliers and subcontractors working with the production. This form is for the production's internal data collection purposes only and will not be submitted to Empire State Development.
