- 1) **Crescent Yacht Club – Lake Ontario Business Resiliency Program (Capital Grant) – Chaumont (North County Region – Jefferson County)** – \$110,482 grant for a portion of the costs to install sheet metal for shorewall replacement along the front of the Clubhouse; raise the existing L-dock with concrete cap; and reinforce shoreline with rip rap along western shoreline; repair/replace western breakwater; replace and strengthen failing wall; and raise the height of the gas pumps and pump-out. In the Junior Division area the grantee will install a breakwall or abutment; replace anchor/tie for docks; replace dock with floating docks; and raise launch area. Total project cost is \$220,964. The project is taking place at 27300 Independence Point Rd, Chaumont.
