

Waiver of Personal Net Worth Eligibility Requirements — Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) Engineering

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 314(4) of the Executive Law, the Director of the Division of Minority and Women's Business Development may waive the personal net worth requirement for Minority- and Women-owned Business Enterprise ("MWBE") eligibility on an industry-wide basis upon determining that the personal net worth requirement, combined with industry-specific factors, has led to the significant exclusion of businesses in that industry from MWBE certification; and,

WHEREAS, upon conducting an availability analysis, I have determined that certified MWBEs are underrepresented in the Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) Engineering industry; and,

WHEREAS, I have determined that industry-specific factors in the Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) Engineering industry, coupled with the personal net worth requirement for MWBE certification, have led to the significant exclusion of businesses in Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) Engineering industry from MWBE certification; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Valerie D. White, Executive Vice President & Executive Director of the Division of Minority and Women's Business Development, do hereby determine that business enterprises in the Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing (MEP) Engineering industry shall be eligible for MWBE certification without regard to the personal net worth requirement for MWBE certification.
