Building Space Available

On Campus

1,688 SF: 82 South Manheim Boulevard, New Paltz NY 12561. Two-family house, garage, two outdoor storage units. The house requires renovation to be appropriate for commercial and/or public use under New York State codes.

1,661 SF: 137 North Chestnut Street, New Paltz NY 12561. Second floor of an office building in downtown New Paltz, owned by a local nonprofit organization. This space is vacant and ready to be occupied.
