

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted General Project Plans (the “Plans”) with respect to all New NY Broadband Program Phase 3 Hughes Network Systems, LLC Projects (the “Projects”) on 7/19/2018 and 11/15/2018. Copies of the Plans are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plans in the offices of the Albany, Allegany, Broome, Cattaraugus, Cayuga, Chautauqua, Chemung, Chenango, Clinton, Columbia, Cortland, Delaware, Dutchess, Erie, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Genesee, Greene, Hamilton, Herkimer, Jefferson, Lewis, Livingston, Madison, Monroe, Montgomery, Niagara, Oneida, Onondaga, Ontario, Orange, Orleans, Oswego, Otsego, Putnam, Rensselaer, Rockland, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Schuyler, Seneca, St. Lawrence, Steuben, Suffolk, Sullivan, Tioga, Tompkins, Ulster, Warren, Washington, Wayne, Westchester, Wyoming and Yates County Clerks. Copies of the Plans are also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and are available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Projects will offer satellite-based broadband service to an estimated 76,873 Unserved customers across the Capital Region, Central New York, Finger Lakes, Long Island, Mid-Hudson, Mohawk Valley, North Country, Southern Tier and Western New York by Hughes Network Systems, LLC. Total Projects costs are expected to be approximately \$23,751,707. ESD proposes to make a \$15,620,785 grant to Hughes Network Systems, LLC to assist in the financing of the Projects.
