Cathryn Taylor Truck n' Trailer.

FINAL ORDER 23-12

From a denial of certification as a Woman-owned Business Enterprise pursuant to Executive Law Article 15-A.

This order arises from an administrative appeal brought on behalf of Cathryn Taylor Truck n' Trailer ("CTTNT" or "Appellant") pursuant to section 144.2 of title 5 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations. Appellant seeks reversal of the decision of the Division of Minority and Women's Business Development (the "Division"), dated April 5, 2023, to deny CTTNT's December 15, 2020, certification application as a Woman-owned Business Enterprise ("WBE").

Applicant submitted a request to appeal on April 24, 2023, and its written appeal by undated letter. The Division submitted its response to the appeal, dated August 25, 2023, together with the affidavit of Amanda Brennan, Project Director, dated August 24, 2023. Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") David A. Murad presided over the appeal. The issues on appeal were whether the woman owner relied upon for certification (1) made a capital contribution to the business enterprise proportionate to her equity interest, demonstrated by, but not limited to, contributions of money, property, equipment or expertise, as required by 5 NYCRR § 144.2(b)(2); (2) demonstrated adequate, industry-specific competence to make critical business decisions without relying upon other persons, as required by 5 NYCRR § 144.2(c)(1); and (3) operates the business enterprise independently, as required under 5 NYCRR § 144.2(e).

On December 11, 2023, the Division received a Recommended Order from Judge Murad that recommended affirmation of the Division's denial of the application to certify Appellant as a WBE on the grounds set forth in the Division's April 5, 2023, denial letter.

After considering the appeal record, I accept the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge as it pertains to the facts of this case. Incorporation by reference is hereby made with respect to the findings and conclusions of the Recommended Order.

It is hereby **ORDERED** that the decision to deny certification, dated April 5, 2023, is affirmed. Accordingly, CTTNT will not be listed on the Division's directory for Minority and Women-owned Business Enterprises.
