The Project involves facility renovations and installation of new machinery and equipment to expand production capacity at this wireless communication and electronics manufacture facility located at 2777 Route East, Cazenovia. Total Project cost are expected to be approximately \$17,438,826. ESD proposes to make a \$1,800,000 grant to Knowles Cazenovia, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other Company Equity.
