

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Wellsville Burrous Building Stabilization Redevelopment Capital Project (the “Project”) on March 26, 2020. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Allegany County Clerk at 7 Court Street, Belmont, New York 14813. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. The Project involves structural repair and construction/renovation of a mixed-use building in order to revitalize the Village of Wellsville’s downtown. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$9,789,300. ESD proposes to make grants of up to \$1,500,000 to the Village of Wellsville to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
