

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Central New York Hub for Emerging Nano Industries Capital (the “Project”) on December 21, 2017. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Onondaga County Clerk at 401 Montgomery Street, Room 200, Syracuse, New York 13202 and in the office of the Dewitt Town Clerk at 5400 Butternut Drive, East Syracuse, New York 13057. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves the purchase, delivery and qualification of machinery, equipment, and tooling of facilities at 50 Collamer Crossings Parkway, East Syracuse, NY 13057, Onondaga County. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$105,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$15,000,000 grant to NexGen Power Systems, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by previously approved grants by the ESD Board in February of 2016. The Project is expected to employ 290 new full-time permanent employees within seven years of project completion.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Dewitt Town Offices located at 5400 Butternut Drive, East Syracuse, New York on January 19, 2018, at 1:30pm to consider the Plan.
