

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Cayuga Nature Center Capital Project (the “Project”) on June 28, 2018. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Tompkins County Clerk at 320 N, Tioga Street, Ithaca, NY 14850. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Cayuga Nature Center (CNC), a public educational venue of the Paleontological Research Institution (PRI) in Tompkins County, will use the funds to continue its renovation, focused on the development and installation of new educational exhibits and renovations to the main lodge building and other infrastructure at 1420 Taughannock Blvd, Ithaca. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$450,000. ESD proposes to make a \$75,000 grant to Cayuga Nature Center to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Ithaca City Hall, 108 E. Green Street on July 18, 2018 at 11:00 a.m., to consider the Plan.
