PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the City of Binghamton North Side First Ward Residential Property Restore NY V (the “Project”) on March 25, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Project involves the demolition of three, vacant, blighted residential buildings totaling 3,178 square-feet to reduce blight and create green space in a residential neighborhood. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$66.750. ESD proposes to make a \$60,000 grant to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
