

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Combined Sewer Separation Project Capital Project (the “Project”) on March 28, 2019. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk at Oneida County Office Building, 800 Park Avenue, Utica, NY 13501 and Utica City Clerk at One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the General Public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes combined sewer separation in a 169-acre area of the Ballou Creek watershed by converting a 66-inch relief sewer into a storm sewer and localized separation in the remaining area including South Street, Steuben Avenue, Arthur Street, and Saint Vincent Street in Utica by the City of Utica. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$11,516,721. ESD proposes to make a \$1,300,000 grant to the City of Utica to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Utica City Hall, Common Council Caucus Room -1st Floor, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, NY 13502 on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 from 10:00am to 11:00am to consider the Plan.
