

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Carrier/Gen-West Capital Project (the “Project”) on July 15, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Cayuga County Clerk at 160 Genesee St., Auburn, NY 13021, and at the City of Auburn Clerks Office 24 South Street, Auburn, New York, 13021. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves construction of a 91,6960 square-foot building including purchase of machinery and equipment to allow Carrier Plastics, Inc. to continue its expansion into the medical market. A new warehouse and clean room will also be a part of the construction at 101 Columbus Street, Auburn. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$16,420,000. ESD proposes to make a \$1,600,000 grant to Gen-West Associates LLC (Carrier Plastics, Inc. is a beneficiary) to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by outside sources.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Cayuga County Office Building 160 Genesee Street, 6th floor, Auburn New York, 13021, On August 4, 2021 from 2:30pm to 3:30pm to consider the Plan.
