

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Galvanize Capital Project (the “Project”) on November 15, 2018. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the New York County Clerk at 60 Centre Street, Room 141B, New York, NY 10007 and The City Clerk, Clerk of the Council, 141 Worth Street, New York, NY 10013. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves the build out and equipping of the Company’s leased 55,000-square-foot facility in lower Manhattan at 315 Hudson Street and 303 Spring Street, New York County. The project will allow Galvanize to train 500 individuals annually to become skilled in the web development and data science fields, as well as support technology startups in their growth efforts. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$8,400,000. ESD proposes to make a \$600,000 grant to Galvanize Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by Company equity. The Project is expected to create 27 new jobs within two years after disbursement of the ESD funds.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Mulberry Street Public Library – Community Room, 10 Jersey Street, New York, NY 10012 on Friday, December 14, 2018 from 2:30pm to 3:30pm to consider the Plan.
