

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Growing Upstate Food Hub Capital Project (the “Project”) on October 18, 2018. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Madison County Clerk at 138 N. Court Street, Wampsville, New York 13163 and in the office of the Canastota Village Clerk at 205 South Peterboro Street, Canastota, New York 13032. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves the construction, planning and design, engineering and initial operating expenses to establish the Growing Upstate Food Hub at 30 Madison Boulevard, Canastota, New York. This will include a shared-use facility with the primary purpose of providing food processing space and refrigeration/frozen product warehousing. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$2,117,807. ESD proposes to make a \$810,000 grant to Growing Upstate Food Hub, LLC to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by grantee equity and other financing sources.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Canastota Village Offices located at 205 South Peterboro Street, Canastota, New York on November 7, 2018, at 10:00am to consider the Plan.
