

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Lake Ontario Business Resiliency Program (the “Program”) on January 21, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in each of the County Clerk’s offices in Jefferson, Monroe, Niagara, St. Lawrence, and Wayne Counties. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. Send email requests to Lake.Ontario@esd.ny.gov Subject: Plan – Lake Ontario Business Resiliency Program.

The Program includes up to \$30 million appropriated from the Resiliency and Economic Development Initiative (REDI) Program that was created as a direct result of the Governor’s declaration of a State of Disaster Emergency as effective on May 20, 2019. The Program funds are to be used to provide reimbursement grants up to \$200,000 for up to 50% of project costs for Eligible Entities to undertake resiliency-related capital improvement projects (“Resiliency Projects”) designed to strengthen their operations against impacts from future flooding.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, as modified by Executive Orders 202.11 and 202.55, the public is given an opportunity to comment
