

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Mohawk Valley Resource Center for Refugees Capital Project (the “Project”) on January 17, 2019. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County Clerk and the Utica City Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the purchase, renovation, and outfitting of a vacant downtown Utica building for the purpose of expanding refugee and immigrant training services at 201 Bleecker Street, Utica by the Mohawk Valley Resource Center for Refugees. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$2,732,166. ESD proposes to make a \$1,748,000 grant to Mohawk Valley Resource Center for Refugees to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the City of Utica - City Hall, Common Council Caucus Room, First Floor, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, New York 13502 on Tuesday, February 12, 2019 from 9:00am to 10:00am, to consider the Plan.
