

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Lake Ontario Small Business Recovery Fund (the “Fund”) February 21, 2019. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in each of the County Clerk’s offices in Niagara and Orleans Counties. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Fund includes up to \$15 million enacted in the 2017-2018 New York State budget to be used to provide grants of up to \$50,000 for repair and/or replacement of direct physical flood-related damage and up to \$50,000 for related revenue loss, or a combination of both, however in no instance shall any grant exceed \$20,000 for owners of multiple dwellings and \$50,000 for all other applicants. Grants cover up to 50% of project costs. Individual applicants located in Finger Lakes and Western New York regions that may be eligible for assistance are listed in the Plan.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at ESD’s Albany office, Conference Room 145, 625 Broadway, Albany, NY 12245 on Thursday March 14, 2019 from 9:00 A.M. to 10:00 A.M., to consider the Plan. Written statements and comments must be emailed to Rebecca.Miller@esd.ny.gov and received by ESD no later than 10:00 AM on March 14, 2019 in order to be considered.
