

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Oneida County Anaerobic Digesters Capital Project (the “Project”) on July 15, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Oneida County Clerk and the City of Utica Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the modernization of the Oneida County Wastewater Treatment Facility, including the construction of two anaerobic digester units at 51 Leland Avenue, Utica by Oneida County. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$52,648,887. ESD proposes to make a \$830,525 grant to Oneida County to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Common Council Caucus Room, First Floor - Utica City Hall, One Kennedy Plaza, Utica, New York 13502, on Friday, August 13, 2021 from 10:00am -11:00am, to consider the Plan.
