

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Herkimer County – Phase II Hurricane Irene/Tropical Storm Lee Flood Mitigation Project (the “Project”) on June 28, 2018. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Herkimer County Clerk, the German Flatts Town Clerk, the Ilion Village Clerk, and the Frankfort Village Clerk. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project involves engineering and designing work for flood mitigation or flood control projects in the creeks, streams and brooks impacted by Hurricane Irene and/or Tropical Storm Lee. An additional \$30,000 would be used to complete hydrologic and hydraulic (“H&H”) modeling of the Otsego Street Bridge. The project locations are at Fulmer Creek, Herkimer County; Steele Creek, Herkimer County; Moyer Creek, Herkimer County; Columbia Parkway, Herkimer County.

Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$716,506. ESD proposes to make a \$716,506 grant to Milone & MacBroom, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Herkimer County Office Building, Legislative Chambers, 3rd Flr, Room #311, 109 Mary Street, Herkimer, NY 13350 on Wednesday, July 18, 2018 from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm, to consider the Plan.
