

## LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Pure Functional Foods Hemp Processing Program Project (the “Project”) on August 20, 2020. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Broome County Clerk at 60 Hawley Street, Binghamton, New York 13902 and the City of Binghamton Clerk at 38 Hawley Street Binghamton, New York 13902. The Project includes installing a hemp seed handling system, hemp seed processing system, and a hemp seed packing system at 120 Chenango Street Binghamton, NY by Pure Functional Foods, Inc. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$770,000. ESD proposes to make a \$385,000 grant to Pure Functional Foods, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project.
