

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the SMART 71 Training Center Capital Project (the “Project”) on September 17, 2020. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Erie County Clerk at 92 Franklin Street, Buffalo, New York 14202. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. The Project combines three adjacent properties into one contiguous property and reconstructs a long neglected, two-story crumbling warehouse into a state-of-the-art training facility. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$1,292,397. ESD proposes to make a \$377,000 grant to the International Association of Sheet Metal Air Rail and Transportation workers Local 71 to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
