PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Stony Brook University Center for the Advanced Study of Drug Action Project (the “Project”) on April 15, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Suffolk County Clerk and the Brookhaven Town Clerk. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. The Project involves the establishment and equipment of a Center for the Advanced Study of Drug Action to improve the success rate of new drug approvals. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$1,250,000. ESD proposes to make a \$250,000 grant to The Research Foundation for SUNY/Stony Brook University to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
