

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act, has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Stony Brook University Next Generation Drug Discovery Facility Capital Project (the “Project”) on August 17, 2017. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Suffolk County Clerk at 310 Center Drive, Riverhead, NY 11901 and Brookhaven Town Clerk at One Independence Hill, Farmingville, NY 11738. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the purchase of machinery and equipment for a drug discovery and biotechnology research facility at 100 Nicolls Road, Stony Brook. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$5,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$500,000 grant to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Town of Brookhaven, Media Room at One Independence Hill, Farmingville, NY 11738 on Thursday, September 14, 2017 from 1:00pm to 2:00pm to consider the Plan.
