

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”) has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Village of Owego-Owego Main Street Rehab Restore V Project (the “Project”) on February 21, 2019. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Tioga County Clerk at 16 Court Street, Owego, NY 13827. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes the rehabilitation of two vacant and blighted buildings totaling more than 11,000-square-feet at the heart of Owego’s Central Historic District at 167-169 Main Street and 171 Main Street, Owego by the Village of Owego. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$1,252,930. ESD proposes to make a \$875,000 grant to the Village of Owego to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE, that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Tioga County Office Building, 56 Main Street, Owego, NY 13827, on March 11, 2019 at 11:00 a.m., to consider the Plan.
