PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Sylvan Beach 13 Canal Street RESTORE IV Capital Project (the “Project”) on August 20, 2020. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Oneida County and Sylvan Beach Village Clerks. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. The Project involves the restoration of 13,850 square-feet of Yesterday’s Royal, including renovations to the building’s foundation and repairs to the roof, windows and flooring. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$550,000. ESD proposes to make a \$500,000 grant to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
