The Project provides funding for the administration/execution of the Workforce Development Challenge Fund for not-for-profit organizations that support programs/efforts in providing workforce development services in key sectors. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$10,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$10,000,000 grant to the Community Foundation for Greater Buffalo, Inc. to assist in the financing of the Project.
