

LEGAL NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as Empire State Development (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Glen Cove Waterfront Connector Capital Project (the “Project”) on February 18, 2021. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the offices of the Nassau County Clerk and the Glen Cove City Clerk. A copy of the Plan is available for inspection by request. Send email requests to: Landgprojectcomments@esd.ny.gov Subject: Glen Cove Waterfront Connector Capital Project.

The Project involves transforming the blighted and contaminated Glen Cove Waterfront into a \$1 billion vibrant new, mixed-use called Garvies Point, the City reconstructed Herb Hill Road and Garvies Point Road into a multi-modal corridor called the Glen Cove Water Connector. Total Project cost is expected to be approximately \$26,209,992. ESD proposes to make a \$2,500,000 grant to City of Glen Cove to assist in the financing of the Project. The remainder of the Project costs will be contributed by other sources.
