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3. Additional Scope of Work:

Subtask 3.1: Feasibility and Specifications for the Installation of a Temporary Fire Alarm System

The Market does not currently have a fire alarm system installed. The project sponsors would like to explore the feasibility of installing a temporary fire safety alarm system that will meet the minimum standard of safety prescribed by City of Buffalo and New York State code. The intent of the temporary system would be to protect the building and occupants during the design and construction phases of the renovation project until a permanent system can be installed.

Previous work has been done to specify a system for the Market (see the following pages). The public address portion of the system was installed in 2022, but the remainder of the system has not been installed.

As an early task in the design process the consultant must:

- Determine the feasibility of installing a temporary fire alarm system that can operate during the design and construction phases of the project that meets the minimum standards of all applicable codes.
- Provide specifications and front-end material that will be delivered to the City of Buffalo (facility owner) to aid in the selection of a qualified vendor to supply and install the system.



GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUPPLY ALL LABOR AND MATERIAL NECESSARY FOR A COMPLETE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM AS SHOWN, TESTED, FULLY OPERATIONAL AND READY TO USE.
- 2. BEFORE SUBMITTING A BID, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VISIT THE PROJECT LOCATION TO DETERMINE ALL EXISTING CONDITIONS THAT WILL AFFECT THE INSTALLATION OF THE PROPOSED MATERIAL AND EQUIPMENT. THE ARCHITECT/ENGINEER/OWNER SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY CONFLICTS FOUND.
- 3. ALL MATERIALS AND INSTALLATION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE APPLICABLE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE, NFPA, ADA, OSHA, AND ALL LOCAL CODES OF THE AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING ALL NECESSARY PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS, INCLUDING ASSOCIATED
- 5. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE ALL MANPOWER, EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS ON-SITE AND READY FOR USE PRIOR TO BEGINNING ANY SHUT-DOWNS OR REMOVING ANY EXISTING SYSTEMS/DEVICES.
- 6. SHUT-DOWN OF ANY EXISTING ELECTRIC SERVICE OR FEEDERS, SHALL BE LIMITED, AS DIRECTED BY OWNER.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP THE AREA OF THE WORK AND ADJACENT AREAS AS FREE FROM MATERIAL, DEBRIS AND RUBBISH AS IS PRACTICABLE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE ALL TEMPORARY STRUCTURES, SURPLUS MATERIAL, TOOLS, EQUIPMENT, IMPLEMENTS AND ALL OTHER MATERIALS CONNECTED WITH OR CAUSED BY THE WORK, IMMEDIATELY UPON THE COMPLETION OF THE WORK. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LEAVE THE BUILDING IN AS GOOD A CONDITION AS WAS FOUND AT THE TIME OF THE BEGINNING OF THE CONTRACT.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR ALL DAMAGE RESULTING FROM ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS WORK AT NO COST TO THE
- 9. ALL MATERIAL AND FIXTURES SHALL BE NEW AND UNUSED, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED. ALL MATERIAL AND FIXTURES SHALL BE U.L. LISTED.
- 10. ALL ELECTRICAL LOADS SHALL BE BALANCED BETWEEN PHASES.
- 11. THE ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE ALL CIRCUIT BREAKERS NECESSARY FOR A COMPLETE SYSTEM INCLUDING SINGLE PHASE AND THREE PHASE.
- 12. CEILING SUPPORT SYSTEMS ARE NOT DESIGNED TO SUPPORT THE WEIGHT OF LIGHT FIXTURES, BOXES, CONDUIT, OR WIRES. ALL SUCH ELEMENTS ARE TO BE SUPPORTED FROM THE BASE BUILDING STRUCTURE.
- 13. CONTRACTOR TO COORDINATE DEVICE LOCATIONS WITH EQUIPMENT BEING SUPPLIED.
- 14. ALL PENETRATIONS THROUGH EXISTING FIRE WALLS SHALL BE SEALED AND CAULKED WITH A LISTED FIRE CAULK.
- 15. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS WITH ACTUAL EQUIPMENT BEING INSTALLED PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.
- 16. ALL PROPOSED DEVICES AND COVERS SHALL MATCH EXISTING.
- 17. ALL EQUIPMENT, DEVICES, AND FIXTURES SHALL BE CLEANED AND TESTED PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE.


